



**FIRST ANNUAL BALDWINVILLE
OKTOBERFEST 5K ROAD RACE
SEPTEMBER 18TH 5:00 PM**

The weekend of September 18th 2010 will mark the 23rd year of the Baldwinville Oktoberfest. There are several exciting changes to this year's event including the location of the venue (River Mall on Downer Street) and the addition of a 5K race featuring Lock 24 on the Erie Canal and beautiful Paper Mill Island (see picture). The race will begin and end at the corner of Crego Road and Tappan Street in Baldwinville. Runners will be treated to arguably one of the most scenic courses in Central New York. The race is also unique in that it is an evening run beginning at 5:00 pm so runners can enjoy what is likely to be a comfortable fall run followed by food and beverages at the Oktoberfest. The course itself is certified by the US Track and Field Association and professional chip timing will be provided by Auyer Timing.

The cost of the race is \$15 up until September 4th; \$20 from September 5th through September 17th; and \$25 for race day registration. Race registration forms are available on line at www.baldwinsvilleoktoberfest.com, and at the "Lock 24 Restaurant" at "The Bikery." On-line registration is also available at www.EZRacereg.com.

All registered runners get an Oktoberfest glass mug and paid entry into the Oktoberfest event. Packet pickup and walk-up race registration will be at the Oktoberfest 5K booth at the River Mall Parking Lot (near Pizza Hut and P&C) on Downer Street on Friday September 17th from 5:00 pm until 7:00 pm and on Saturday September 18th from Noon until 3:00 pm.
